FIELD WORK AND CROP DEVELOPMENT SLOWED BY COOL, WET WEATHER CONDITIONS

Row crops and small grains are still being harvested at a slow pace, and small grains continue to develop gradually. There were 2.6 days suitable for fieldwork last week, nearly a full day less than the previous week. Topsoil moisture rated 1 percent very short, 1 percent short, 56 percent adequate, and 42 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture rated 1 percent very short, 1 percent short, 59 percent adequate, and 39 percent surplus.
